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INTRODUCTION

I. Introduction

A. Upper Respiratory Tract (above the larynx) Specimens include:

Throat swabs
Epiglottal swabs
Nasal/nasopharyngeal aspirates / swabs
Mouth swabs
Oral abscess swabs / aspirates
Sinus or antral aspirates

B. Lower Respiratory Tract Specimens include:

Sputum
Bronchial aspirates (washings)
Bronchial brushings
Bronchoalveolar lavage (BAL)
Lung biopsies
Lung Aspirates
Open Lung biopsies

Note: Lower respiratory tract specimens may be contaminated with organisms found in the upper respiratory tract (<u>Commensal Flora – Respiratory Tract</u>). Sputum samples are screened to assess the amount of oropharyngeal contamination before processing.
